Volunteer Income Tax Assistance (VITA) - Free Income Tax Preparation

The Volunteer Income Tax Assistance (VITA) Program is a national program sponsored by the Internal Revenue Service (IRS) to help families who earned less than \$64,000 in 2023 maximize their tax returns and avoid the fees businesses charge to prepare taxes. Since 2008 Fairfax County Department of Family Services has provided operational support to the coalition partners.

Chicken and Wild Rice Casserole

Ingredients:

4 chicken breasts (cooked and cubed)

8 ounces (oz.) sour cream

2 cans cream of mushroom soup

 $\frac{1}{2}$ (tsp) salt

½ (tsp) pepper

2 boxes of wild rice

 $4 (C) + \frac{1}{2} (C)$ chicken broth

 $\frac{1}{2}$ stick of butter + 2 (T) butter

2 stalks chopped celery

1 chopped onion

Instructions:

Preheat oven to 350 degrees.

Cook wild rice according to directions on packages, using chicken broth instead of water. In a saucepan combine rice, chicken broth, and 2

Bring contents to a boil, reduce heat, and simmer covered for 25 minutes or until water is absorbed.

In a frying pan, sauté chopped celery and chopped onion in ½ stick of butter until vegetables are tender.

In a large bowl, combine: sour cream, soup, ½ teaspoon (tsp) salt, ½ teaspoon (tsp) pepper Cooked rice, Sauteed vegetables

Fold in chicken breasts with a rubber spatula. Spread ingredients into a 9 x13-inch pan. Bake for 30 minutes until hot.
